The Journey

The Hunza Autumn Tour is one of the most visually spectacular tours in our portfolio. Every October and November, Hunza Valley transforms into a painter's canvas — apricot orchards and poplar-lined irrigation channels turn brilliant gold, amber and rust-red against the stark white of freshly-snowed Karakoram peaks. Why October in Hunza? Autumn in Hunza Valley rivals — and for many visitors surpasses — the famous cherry blossom spring. The golden foliage is uniquely intense: apricot leaves turn deep yellow-orange, poplars become columns of gold and the harvested terraces take on rich ochre tones. All of this unfolds below Rakaposhi (7,788m) and Ultar Sar (7,388m) with their fresh October

Day-by-Day

Arrive in Hunza to first light at Eagle's Nest and a welcome of autumn colour.
- 2 DAY** **2438 m**
Karimabad Forts
Baltit and Altit forts above golden poplar terraces at peak colour.
- 3 DAY** **2438 m**
Attabad & Passu
Attabad Lake, the Passu Cones, and Gulmit - autumn reflections on turquoise water.
- 4 DAY** **2438 m**
Nagar Valley
Nagar valley and the Rakaposhi viewpoint, past red apricot orchards and harvest villages.
- 5 DAY** **2438 m**
Eagle's Nest Sunrise
A Duikar Eagle's Nest sunrise over the full autumn sweep of the Hunza valley.
- 6 DAY** **2438 m**
Karimabad & Hopper
Karimabad bazaar, a local Hunzakut lunch, and a walk to Hopper Glacier.
- 7 DAY** **540 m**
Gilgit & Depart
Drive to Gilgit and fly to Islamabad for departure.

What's Included

Included

- All ground transport in Hunza and Nagar by private vehicle, 6 nights hotel, daily breakfast and dinner, and a local guide throughout.
- All listed sightseeing and entry fees — Baltit Fort, Altit Fort, Attabad Lake boat ride.

Booking & Payment

- A deposit of \$80 per person confirms your seat. The balance is due 21 days before departure.
- Book through our website, WhatsApp, or an authorized agent — every booking is confirmed in writing.
- Prices are held once your deposit is received and may otherwise change with season and availability.

Cancellation Policy

- Cancel 30+ days before departure: full refund minus the deposit.
- Cancel 14–29 days before: 50% refund of the total paid.
- Cancel under 14 days before: no refund, as rooms and transport are already booked.

Permits & Documentation

- Foreign guests need a standard Pakistan tourist visa — no restricted-zone trekking permit is required. We provide a Letter of Invitation on request.
- A small Baltit/Altit fort entry and local community fee applies and is included.
- Carry your passport and ID; valid travel and medical insurance is recommended.

Health & Fitness

- Easy. Comfortable vehicle transfers with short walks at forts, viewpoints and the Karimabad bazaar.
- Hunza sits around 2,438m — gentle altitude. Mornings are cold in autumn, so bring a warm layer.
- Suitable for families and photographers. Tell us of any medical needs so we can pace the days.
