The Journey

The K6 & K7 Base Camp Trek is one of the Karakoram's finest off-the-beaten-path adventures — a journey through the stunning Charakusa Valley to the base camps of K6 (7,040m) and K7 (6,934m), two of Pakistan's most dramatic and technically demanding peaks. While the Baltoro Glacier draws thousands of trekkers each year, the Charakusa Valley sees only a handful of expeditions — offering the same quality of Karakoram scenery in almost complete solitude. The Charakusa Valley is accessed from the village of Hushe in the Ghanche District of Gilgit-Baltistan — one of Pakistan's most beautiful Balti villages, surrounded by towering granite walls and glaciated peaks. Day-by-Day

- 1** **540 m**
Arrive Islamabad
Arrive in Islamabad for the briefing and gear check.
- 2** **2500 m**
Fly to Skardu
Fly to Skardu (2,500m) and begin the drive toward Hushe Valley.
- 3** **3100 m**
Skardu to Hushe
Drive to Hushe village (3,100m), the trailhead, and prep for the trail.
- 4** **3100 m**
Rest at Hushe
An acclimatization day at Hushe with a walk and porter briefing.
- 5** **3600 m**
Into Charakusa
Trek to Sona Phari (3,600m) at the entrance to the Charakusa valley.
- 6** **4200 m**
K7 Base Camp
Climb to K7 Base Camp (4,200m) for first views of K7 (6,934m).
- 7** **4200 m**
Charakusa Glacier
Explore around K7 Base Camp with a walk on the Charakusa Glacier.
- 8** **4500 m**
K6 Base Camp
Move to K6 Base Camp (4,500m) under the wall of K6 (7,040m).
- 9** **4500 m**
Naysar Approach
A rest day at K6 Base Camp with an approach walk toward Naysar Peak.
- 10** **4500 m**
Both Peaks in View
A photography day at K6 Base Camp with both K6 and K7 in view.
- 11** **4200 m**
Charakusa Circuit
Trek back to K7 Base Camp, completing the full Charakusa valley circuit.
- 12** **3600 m**
Begin Descent
Begin the descent, dropping to Sona Phari (3,600m).

Back to Hushe

Trek out to Hushe village - the trek is complete.

14

2500 m

Skardu via Khaplu

Drive to Skardu with a stop at Khaplu Palace.

15

2500 m

Skardu Rest Day

A rest day in Skardu with a celebration dinner.

540 m

Departure

Fly from Skardu to Islamabad for departure.
