## The Journey

The North Pakistan Jeep Safari is the ultimate overland adventure along one of the world's most spectacular roads — a 12-day 4x4 expedition along the Karakoram Highway, exploring the remote valleys, high plateaus, ancient forts and dramatic landscapes of Gilgit-Baltistan from the back of a purpose-equipped Land Cruiser. This is Pakistan seen at road level — raw, vast and unforgettable. Why Jeep Safari? The Karakoram Highway and its tributary roads pass through terrain that cannot be appreciated from a bus or plane. A dedicated 4x4 jeep allows you to stop at any viewpoint, turn off onto unmade tracks to remote villages, cross river fords and reach corners of Gilgit-Baltistan that no standard

## Day-by-Day

- 1** **2500 m**  
**Arrive in Skardu**  
Arrive in Skardu, visit Kharpocho Fort, and get briefed for the jeep safari ahead.
- 2** **2500 m**  
**Katpana & Shigar**  
4x4 across the Katpana cold desert to Satpara Lake, then a drive through Shigar Valley.
- 3** **4114 m**  
**Deosai National Park**  
Onto the Deosai plateau (4,114m): Sheosar Lake, brown-bear country, and the source of the Astore River.
- 4** **4114 m**  
**Deosai Upper Plateau**  
A second day high on Deosai - the hanging bridge, wildflower fields, and marmots everywhere.
- 5** **2438 m**  
**Deosai to Hunza**  
Descend off the plateau and drive to Hunza via Gilgit on the Karakoram Highway.
- 6** **2438 m**  
**Hunza Valley**  
A full Hunza day: Eagle's Nest, Baltit and Altit forts, and turquoise Attabad Lake.
- 7** **4693 m**  
**Khunjerab Pass (4,693m)**  
Drive to the Khunjerab Pass at 4,693m - the China border and the highest paved international crossing in the world.
- 8** **2438 m**  
**Passu & Hussaini Bridge**  
The Passu Cones, Gulmit village, and the nerve-testing Hussaini suspension bridge.
- 9** **2500 m**  
**Nagar & Rakaposhi**  
Nagar valley and the Rakaposhi viewpoint, then on toward Gilgit.
- 10** **2500 m**  
**Toward Fairy Meadows**  
Drive to the Fairy Meadows jeep track and begin the approach to Nanga Parbat.
- 11** **3300 m**  
**Fairy Meadows**  
Time at Fairy Meadows (3,300m) under the north face of Nanga Parbat (8,126m).
- 12** **540 m**  
**Drive South & Depart**  
Drive south down the Karakoram Highway to Islamabad for departure.

## Included

- Private ground transport throughout, including all 4x4 transfers.
- Hotel accommodation and all meals per the itinerary.
- A licensed local guide, all entry fees, and daily sightseeing.

## Not Included

- International flights to and from Pakistan, and the Pakistan visa fee.

## Booking & Payment

- A deposit of \$100 per person confirms your spot. Full payment is due 14 days before departure.
